# GROUP COMMITTEE PROPERTY REPORT

#### The Barn

The Barn is in good shape despite the ongoing fragile position of our sewage lines and the tree root problem.

In 2017 we installed a new shaker style kitchen with almond stone benchtops after removing an internal wall and extending the space. This was done in order to facilitate small group of children working in collaboration and to provide an in and out door system for safety reasons.

In 2018 we will be sanding and re oiling the upstairs level and painting the outdoor toilet.

The Barn continues to provide strong but modest revenue from hire practices.

#### **Freeston Hall**

Freeston Hall is in reasonable shape with a makeover scheduled for the April school holidays. Mulching, fire pit sanding and an internal paint.

A new kitchen will the result of a successful 2017 Community Partnerships Grant Funding application. This will assist the group for activities and increase the hire potential.

The storeroom has been cleaned thanks to David Day and camping equipment relocated to it from the Port Jackson Boatshed.

#### **Port Jackson Boatshed Balmoral**

The security arrangements onboard HMAS Penguin have escaled to a high alert so access is an ongoing problem. This will not be remedied in the foreseeable future due to a change of Commanding Officer.

Building 35 is temporarily closed as the Navy renovate the storeroom beneath to keep out unwanted nature. This will be completed over the Winter months in time for the 2018 Summer Season.
